Position Description

POSITION TITLE: Field Worker/Laborer; Forestry Program

OBJECTIVE:

Perform field labor work such as forest inventory, vegetation mapping, hazard fuel reduction and other Forestry Program projects.

QUALIFICATIONS: Job qualifications are stated below as Essential Job Results. Candidates must demonstrate their ability to accomplish these results. **Absolute requirements:** Must be at least 18 years of age and available to work from October 2016 to April 2017 **Preferred:** Similar work experience including familiarity with running a chain saw and experience with using GPS. Valid Alaska driver's license and a clean driving record. Familiarity with Bristol Bay area, people, and cultures. Familiarity with restricted property sites.

Physical demands: Field work will require physical abilities to: operate a chainsaw safely as well as other equipment and provide limited maintenance; withstand harsh environmental conditions, travel by small aircraft, helicopter, ATV's, and boats; work extended periods in field locations both in summer and winter; walk at least six miles per day in rugged terrain; lift and carry up to 50 pounds, sit, stand, walk, bend, stoop, stretch, and reach; visual and audio abilities.

ESSENTIAL JOB RESULTS

by

- Following instructions of Field Supervisor regarding: project requirements, schedule, work practices and details.
- Completing a safety training provided by BBNA staff.
- Paying attention to and avoiding work hazards, wearing and maintaining safety equipment including chaps, hardhat, eye/ear protection and gloves. (chaps, hardhat, eye/ear protection provided for project).
- Reporting all injuries immediately to Field Supervisor.
- Traveling by foot, ATV or truck (transportation provided) to selected areas of field work.
- Providing updates to Field Supervisor on a daily basis during project.
- Cutting, trimming, and hauling wood and brush. Cutting useable wood into manageable pieces, hauling and stacking at safe locations.
- Removing limbs, slash, debris and brush cut by saw crew to trucks or flatbeds, deliver to landfill burn box.
