



Announcing future USDA Community Facilities grant opportunities...

- **CF Grant pre-applications will be accepted September 1-November 15, 2016**
- Eligible entities may include tribal governments, city and borough governments and non-profit organizations
- All Community Facility grants are competitive
- Maximum grant funding is \$50,000 with a minimum match requirement of 25%

Announcing USDA Community Facilities loan opportunities...

- ✓ Eligible entities may include tribal governments, city and borough governments and non-profit organizations
- ✓ No down payment required
- ✓ Low Interest Rates (lower than bank/credit union rates)

Examples of projects that may be eligible for Community Facilities grant and/or loan funding may include, and are not limited to the following:

- ***Community buildings** such as city hall, community center, tribal office, washeteria, clinics.
- **Equipment** purchases such as heavy equipment, biomass boilers, etc.
- **Energy improvement retrofits** for *buildings and equipment.
- **Purchases to support local food systems** such as community gardens, food pantries, community kitchens, food banks, food hubs or greenhouses
- **Loans and Grants may be combined to fund a project**
